IMPORTANT INFORMATION

My English is not sufficient to explain the necessary you need to know about my assistance dog.

My dog is a very well trained dog and is focused on me and my behavior. I need my dog to be with me at all times. Not only is my dog able to help me with opening doors or getting dressed.

My dog knows and senses when I am getting ill, going to have a seizure, or have a panic attack.

I carry with me a certified assistance dog pass to confirm that my assistance dog is to be with me at all times. My dog wears an assistance dogs harness.

I have official documents needed to travel with my assistance dog:

Assistance Dog ID – issued by a member of Assistance Dogs Europe, Assistance Dogs International or European Guide Dog Federation.
